

INTRA-PROTEO INTERNSHIP COMPETITION FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS, POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND RESEARCH PROFESSIONALS (2026 EDITION)



Intra-PROTEO internship scholarship objectives

- This program aims to provide financial support to PROTEO students, postdoctoral fellows and research professionals who wish to acquire practical knowledge and/or use cutting-edge infrastructure by doing an internship in a PROTEO member's laboratory.

Description of scholarships

- Scholarships of up to **\$1,500** are awarded for an internship of up to 10 days.
- An internship is a practical training opportunity offered exclusively to PROTEO students, postdoctoral fellows and research professionals who wish to acquire new techniques and skills in the laboratories of a PROTEO member researcher. Financial support is available exclusively for **internships at institutions outside the applicant's city of residence.**

Eligibility requirements

- All PROTEO student members, under the direction of a regular member, enrolled full-time at the graduate level and all PROTEO postdoctoral fellows and research professionals are eligible.
- A candidate may receive only one intra-PROTEO internship grant per degree level (M.Sc. or Ph.D.). Therefore, a person who has received a grant for a master's internship may apply again at the doctoral level.
- A candidate may only apply for the scholarship if his or her supervisor has read the application file, approved the application, and agreed to pay the remaining costs of the candidate's participation in the internship if the scholarship does not cover all costs, in accordance with the estimated costs given in the application form.
- Applications must reach the PROTEO coordinator before the start of the internship to ensure that funds are available.

Application submission

Payment of the scholarship

- Payment of the scholarship (in the form of reimbursement of expenses) is made on presentation of supporting documents for eligible expenses (up to a total of \$1,500), and according to the terms and conditions set by PROTEO once the internship is over (see Appendix Eligible Expenses).
